- 1. Fire Road: No Update**
- 2. Marijuana ordinance:** Selectman Fish is attending a workshop at the Cross Center in Bangor that will explain what the State is implementing for laws with regard to marijuana use, then the Selectmen will work on drafting an ordinance.
