1. **Report on Sunrise Care Facility:** DECH denied the request by the Selectman to give a 6- month reprieve from closing the facility.
2. **Ice Hill South:** A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken to hold a public hearing as soon as possible on the Ice Hill South road discontinuance.

3. **Phone call during meeting, property owner-71 Fire Rd.:** Phone call from property owner about the culvert running under her driveway. It was explained that it was her responsibility to replace it.
4. **Food Truck/W. Jonesport Park:** Selectmen agree adjustments made to the food truck would now be a non- issue. They requested that a food truck item be placed on the agenda in December.
5. **Marilyn Mazza-sidewalk issue:** MDOT will be coming in to fix roads. Sidewalks will be addressed after roads resurfaced.
6. **Approval of new road name, Seabreeze Place:** A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken, to allow a new lane to be named Seabreeze Place, at the request of the owner, Mary Borer. A sign will be ordered for the new road.
7. **Cut down rosebushes? 298 Kelley Point Rd.:** Bo Beal will be notified to remove some of the branches from the rosebushes so that visibility will be improved.

8. **FYI Clean Water State Revolving Fund 2018:** The information shows how the funds will be expended for the 2018 year.
9. Bo Beal will address the washout in West Jonesport.
10. The Harbor Committee will be informed of handicapped parking abuse at the marina.
11. Selectman Fish gave a report from PRSWDD.
