OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Report on Sunrise Care Facility:** The Selectmen are negotiating with the DECH Board to obtain the property for the Town; with the beds it is valued at 1.2 million. At present, no plans have been made as to how it will be used.
- 2. Ice Hill South:** There will be a public hearing at 5:00 p.m. on July 25th for the public to be heard on the discontinuance of this road. All land owners have been notified of the hearing.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 3. ShoreUp Maine Grant, John Church:** A motion was made by Selectman Milliken, seconded by Selectman Alley to submit a letter of support for the two grants: One grant is to obtain aerial footage of the Campground property and the second grant for an engineer design of the road which partly washes out in the winter/spring months.

MISCELLANEOUS:

- 4. Salt bid for 2018-19:** Tabled until next week
- 5. Sandy River Beach- dog problem:** Selectman Milliken will talk to Attorney Hamer to receive the proper wording for the sign to be put on the beach to deter beach users from being disrespectful of property and leaving trash, dog waste etc. along the beach.
- 6. PRSWDD:** There will be a proposal from Fran Havey submitted to the Town Office, either by email or regular mail in the next few weeks.
- 7. Noise complaint:** The Selectmen received a complaint about the CPM crew starting at 5:00 am.; the crew drives too fast through town and rocks are tumbling out of the truck. The roads are being ruined. Selectman Milliken will call MDOT and talk to Phil Roberts about some of the concerns.

- 8. Fire Station bathrooms:** The bathrooms at the fire station will be closed. A motion was made by Fish, seconded by Alley to place a port a potty at the ball diamond, which is in the middle of the Town. Selectman Milliken will call the person cleaning the Fire Station bathrooms and tell her those services will no longer be needed.
- 9. Breeze Street:** There was a complaint about the unsanitary condition of property located on the corner of Breeze Street. The property is also an eyesore because of all the junk piled around. Selectman Milliken will talk to the owner and tell them the property needs to be cleaned up.

A motion was made by Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectman Fish to adjourn the meeting at 5 p.m.
