1. **Report on Sunrise Care Facility:** The Board of Directors at DECH are meeting on Friday. There should be an update by the next Selectmen's meeting.

MISCELLANEOUS:

2. **Salt bid for 2018-19:** Bimbo Look cannot purchase the Town salt for less than \$80 a ton. Selectmen decided to see if the County can get a lower bid.
3. **Sandy River Beach:** Information on the proposed sign has been submitted to Attorney Hamer. The Selectmen are waiting for a reply.
4. **Noise complaint:** CPM has been made aware of the complaint.
5. **Fire Station bathrooms:** The bathrooms at the fire station will be closed. A port a potty will be placed on the ball diamond with a sign showing new location of a public restroom.
6. **Breeze Street:** No update.
7. **Sandy River lights:** A motion was made by Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectmen Fish not to send the lights for repair until after Labor Day.
8. Selectmen Fish has been appointed to the County Budget Committee. The first meeting will be the second week in Sept.

9. The Town has expended only \$400 from the \$100,000 earmarked for the ongoing drug problem in Jonesport.
10. The signs at the Campground and the Albert Kelley road sign need to be straightened.
11. The money for work at the tennis courts became available on July 1st.
12. A new lower speed sign on Main Street was discussed but it is a MDOT issue.
13. There will be a State report on the MDOT mobile speed sign available in the near future.
