3. **Moratorium Ordinance - marijuana:** A new law became effective on May 2<sup>nd</sup> concerning adult retail sales. An ordinance will be discussed at the next Selectmen's meeting.
4. **Ethel N. Kelley Memorial Award:** The Selectmen will pursue nominating a citizen for this award. Five letters of support will be needed.
5. A complaint was received about speeding traffic near Byron Carver's property. The Selectmen suggested that DOT may be able to post a Deaf sign in the vicinity.
6. A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Alley to post a warrant for a Special Town Meeting to be scheduled for August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The articles will include the discontinuance of Ice Hill South and the Moratorium Ordinance for marijuana adult retail sales.
7. A motion was made by Selectman Milliken, seconded by Selectman Alley to ask CPM not to dump or load any rocks between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Selectman Milliken will contact CPM.
