MISCELLANEOUS:

- 1. Sandy River Beach:** At the last meeting, the Selectmen requested the wording from the property owners for a sign to be erected at the Beach. They will be contacted again.
- 2. Complaint from property owner adjacent to old IGA:** The Selectmen will ask Jim Carver to inspect the building and give them an update on its condition. Mr. Crouthamel will be advised of this decision.

- 3. Presentation by AFLAC representative:** A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken to allow an AFLAC representative to give a presentation to all Town employees, including the teachers.
- 4. Painting Skating Pond building:** The Selectmen decided to wait another year before having the building at the skating pond painted. Sheldon Merritt will be informed of their decision. The project will be added to the 2019-20 Annual Town Meeting Warrant.
- 5. Moratorium Ordinance - marijuana:** The moratorium is ready for the August 29th Special Town Meeting and will be presented to the townspeople for their vote at that time.

- 7. PRSWDD Interlocal Agreement:** The Selectmen requested that the old agreement along with the new one be sent to Attorney Hamer for his advice.
