NEW BUSINESS:

1. **WCCOG**-Sept 25 6-8pm @ Crystal's Office -final Executive Committee meeting for fiscal year. – Harry Fish -let him know
2. **MMA: Federal Rural Broadband Grant Pilot Program:** they are looking for comments regarding three issues – comments due Sept 5, 2018. Send a note stating the fact for the need of broadband in our area: 1. Enable people to work from home, 2. Increase in business for area

She had contacted them, and they told her to contact the town and have the town call. The office spoke with Jacob Worcestor and he is in the process of seeing what it would cost to add the expansion. There is no fiber within two (2) miles in each direction of her location and he did state it could be fairly costly. -update when more information is received
