NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Free speed signs from MDOT:** A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectmen Alley to request three free speed signs from MDOT.

2. **Sunrise Care Facility:** DECH is offering the facility building to the Arnold Memorial Medical Center without beds. No longer a Town matter.
3. **IGA-Inspection Results:** Selectman Milliken will contact owner about removing area of building that may be or become a hazard.
4. **Jewett Rd/Shellfish Committee:** No update. Shellfish Committee not in attendance.
