OLD BUSINESS:

1. **IGA:** A letter was received from Mr. Crouthamel, the abutting property owner of the IGA. The owner of the IGA contacted him stating that the necessary repairs will be made to the building by April 2019.
2. **Grants:** Crystal Hitchings, with WCCOG, is searching for grants to assist with the extension of the recreational trail and the waterfront development of the Campground.
3. **Feedback signs:** The Town will be getting one of the free speed limit signs. Selectman Alley signed the Cooperative Agreement to be returned to the State.

MISCELLANEOUS:
