NEW BUSINESS: NONE

OLD BUSINESS:

1. **Junkyard hearing:** The property owner was found to be in contempt of court and ordered to pay \$2900.in fees. A motion was made by Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectman Fish to designate Betsy Fitzgerald, asst. CEO, to meet with the owner and tell him what exactly must be removed from his 79 Fire Road property.
2. **Law enforcement:** Lubec pays \$5000. annually to have a deputy sheriff patrol their Town randomly. The Selectmen are looking into this option and would also like to meet with the Addison and Beals Selectmen and see if these towns may want to share a deputy or make some other plan for law enforcement jointly with Jonesport.

MISCELLANEOUS:

3. **Storm Drains on Main Street:** The Commissioner of Transportation will be contacted to submit a complaint that the storm drains on Main Street have not been repaired as promised and ask that they be repaired before winter.
4. **Marijuana Moratorium:** Once more information is gathered, Selectman Fish will meet with the Planning Board to see what guidelines need to be put into place.
5. **Road proclamation:** The amended road proclamation was signed. The original proclamation was prepared using 911 info which was incorrect.
6. **Fire Dept. parking:** A letter will be sent to Paul's Garage to make sure the road in and out of the Fire Dept. stays clear of vehicles.

7. **Beaver on the Fire Road:** Luther Choate has placed traps to catch the beaver that may remain in residence.
8. **Permission to put a “dead end” sign on end of Seabreeze Place:** This is a private road and no permission is needed to place signs. The cost is at the expense of the landowners.
9. **Dig out ditches near Thomas Keene property:** Bo needs to be contacted to take care of this problem on Main Street.

Deke Talbot will be notified to prepare a deed and transfer tax statement for the property gifted to the Town on Kelley Point Road.

A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken to erect a new gate to the Campground beyond Ray Nichols driveway. Selectman Milliken will put up flags designating where it should go.

A motion to adjourn was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Alley at 5:10 p.m.
