1. **Junkyard report from designee:** Betsy Fitzgerald, the designee, met with the land owner and laid out a plan with him to get the property cleaned up and set a time frame to the first weekend in December to check on progress.
2. **Law enforcement: No Update.**

3. **Campground gate: No Update.**
4. **Report on Fire Road:** Luther Choate, who is the beaver trapper, suggested that the Town clear away the old beaver dams. He feels there is no beaver activity on the Fire Road at this time.
5. **Middle ground clamming:** An email was received from the Town of Addison stating that they prefer the Middle Ground agreement signed in October of 2012 remain in place for clam digging. This item will be tabled until the December 5th meeting.

6. **Repairs at Town office:** This is an issue for the Health Care Board of Arnold Memorial.
7. **Wastewater grant:** There is a use for a grant for overboard discharge. Crystal Hitchings will be contacted to see if the Town meets the qualifications.
8. The winter sand/salt has been put up for the upcoming winter season.
9. A public hearing was held in Addison concerning future solid waste contracts but Mark Wright wasn't in attendance. In the future, Jonesport will host a public hearing, with Mark Wright, to answer questions the citizens of the Town may have before an article is submitted at the Annual Town Meeting.
10. **PRSWDD:** PERC not closing but more expensive. Fiber-rite won't be up and operating for a undetermined length of time. PRSWDD is contacting an attorney for advice as far as non-compliance of the contract by Fiber-rite.
