OLD BUSINESS:

1. **Food Truck Ordinance:** The Ordinance will need a public hearing and then will be added to the school warrant to be voted on by the townspeople.
2. **Adult Use Marijuana Moratorium Ordinance:** There will be a public hearing to extend the moratorium for an additional 180 days.
3. **Quit Claim deed for property located on map 006-062:** The deed was signed by all Selectmen and will be mailed back to Talbot and Talbot.

NEW BUSINESS:

4. **John Church-grants:** The SHIP grant is taking applications. Crystal Hitchings will be contacted for her input as to whether Jonesport should apply or not.
5. **Grants:** Numerous grants have been released including a recreational trail grant which may be of interest to the Town. It would include the Sandy River Beach area.

MISCELLANEOUS:

6. **Michael Church, questions concerning Look appeal-conference call 460-2351:** The Selectmen called Michael. He was interested in who is responsible for the maintenance and plowing of the part of Jonesport Ave. owned by the Looks.

7. **PRSWDD:** A letter will be written to PRSWDD informing the Board that the citizens of Jonesport voted to not opt-in to a contract with PRSWDD.
8. **Maine DOT FYI:** The Selectmen perused the info provided from MDOT with no discussion.
9. **Cemetery fence insurance claim:** The accident involving the cemetery fence was discussed. Arnie Smith, who built it, will be contacted for an estimate to repair the fence.
10. Bimbo Look, the snow plow contractor, discussed complaints that were received by the Selectmen and how he would like to see them handled.
11. Jay Gawkowski asked that a streetlight be put on the pole in the area of his house to dissuade cars parking there. He will call the office with the pole number.
12. There is a course for planning and appeal boards to be held in Orono in September. The Selectmen offered to pay for all attending members plus mileage reimbursement.
13. A discussion was held about how often the deputies should report to the Town with invoices and activity. It was decided quarterly would work well.
14. **Executive Session: Personnel Matters 1 M.S.R.A. 405 (6)(A):**The Selectmen entered into executive session at 5:20 p.m. and returned to the general meeting at 5:45.
