4. **Fire Road** – Selectman Milliken gave an update that the residents involved would be willing to sign an agreement regarding the bus turn around. Selectman Milliken will draft an agreement.

At this time the Selectmen ask the Chandlers' to put their land work on hold until they are able to check into this matter. **
