OLD BUSINESS:

1. **Early Bird Food Truck estimate:** Kevin Rocks will do the work where the Early Bird Food Truck will be in the spring and summer months. A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken to approve the estimate and to close the West Jonesport Park until further notice. Danielle Rocks will be notified when it reopens. Selectman Alley, Selectman Fish and Selectman Milliken, all voted "Aye."
2. **US Cellular:** A motion was made by Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectman Fish to table this item until next week. Selectman Fish, Selectman Milliken and Selectman Alley all voted "Aye".
3. **Harbor Committee:** Two dolphins and 6 pilings will be put in on the West side of the Marina. A remote vote was held by the Harbor Committee, with Buddy Mills, Ernest Jr., Harry Fish, Russell Batson and John Church, all voting for the project. The cost will be approximately \$22,000. The Selectmen approved the expenditure with a motion made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken. Selectman Fish, Selectman Milliken and Selectman Alley all voted "Aye".

MISCELLANEOUS:

4. **PRSWDD Agreement:** A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken to accept the Agreement as written. Selectman Fish will contact the Attorney, Kate Grossman and ask that she present it to the PRSWDD attorney. A Town vote will be needed because the cost to the Town could be \$15,000. or more. Selectman Fish, Selectman Alley, and Selectman Milliken all voted "Aye".
5. **Local Roads Center: FYI.**
6. **Working remotely:** A motion was made by Selectman Milliken, seconded by Selectman Fish to revisit this item next week. Selectman Milliken and Selectman Alley voted "Aye." Connection lost from Selectman Fish.
7. Bimbo Look joined Zoom by phone to talk about snowplow contract. The increase will be 3% each year, with a \$4200 increase over last year for the coming year then an increase of 3% each year the Town contracts with Look.
