### NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Water and Sewer Study:** Brent Bridges will be joining the next Selectmen's Board meeting to explain where the Town is at this time in the process.

### OLD BUSINESS:

2. **PRSWDD Agreement:** A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken to accept the last Agreement as written, with the only change being in Section H where the PRSWDD attorney would like to add the phrase, "violates joinder agreement." Selectman Alley, Selectman Fish, and Selectman Milliken, all voted "Aye."
3. **Kristian Crowley, Medical Marijuana fees:** An email will be sent to John Hamer asking if the Medical Marijuana Ordinance can be changed by the Selectmen to accept quarterly payments for the second year of operation.
4. **Sandy River Beach:** Dennis Moriasey will fix the cement planks for \$1500. A motion was made by Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectman Fish to take up to \$1500 out of contingency funds for the repairs. Until it is repaired, no heavy equipment will be allowed to go over the planks because they will break. Selectman Alley, Selectman Fish, and Selectman Milliken, all voted "Aye."
5. **Sheriff's Dept.:** Sherriff Curtis will call Selectman Fish concerning the new contract.
6. **Michah Jasney, Mistake Island:** The Selectmen do not own the Moosabec Lighthouse which is where Michah would like to collect seeds. Selectman Milliken will check with the owner to receive permission.
7. **Planning Board and Board of Appeals training:** A Zoom meeting will be held July 30<sup>th</sup>. All Planning Board and Board of Appeals members will be contacted to see who would like to attend. Selectman Milliken will be joining the meeting also.

8. Rockwell Road has been paved.
9. A Kingfish Maine meeting will be held at the Jonesport Fire Station and on Zoom on July 21<sup>st</sup> at 6 pm.
10. The Stillman Creek project is ready for RFPs. A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken to put the project out for bid. Any bids will have to have a due date of August 21<sup>st</sup> or 28<sup>th</sup>. Specifications will be made available. The bridge for the project will be ordered from Dirigo and stored in the Sand/Salt Shed. The project should be finished by late October but paving won't be done until next spring. Selectman Alley, Selectman Fish, and Selectman Milliken, all voted "Aye."
11. A meeting concerning Covid-19 will be held at the Beals Town Office July 16<sup>th</sup> at 7p.m. The Selectmen would like Jay Gawkowski to attend, as the Town's Local Emergency Officer.
12. Bill McDonald suggested that Michael Soucy may be a possible appraiser for the Jonesport Campground property. Selectman Milliken will do the negotiations with him.

A motion to adjourn was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken at 5:03p.m. Selectman Alley, Selectman Fish, and Selectman Milliken, all voted "Aye."
