NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Water and Sewer Study:** Brent Bridges explained that funding agencies are always interested in providing money to towns for upgrading water and sewer. The State would rather not have runoff from sewers go into the ocean. Brent will work with Bill McDonald to try and get funding for seed money to start looking at the project. The Selectmen would rather the main concern be about updating the sewer over a water study, if a decision had to be made. In 2006, there was no interest in changing the water or sewer in Town. The documents from 2006 will be updated by Brent and Bill. Project would again have to be voted on by the Town's people.

OLD BUSINESS:

2. **PRSWDD Agreement:** There is a small problem with the agreement. The attorney, representing the Town in this case, will address it with the PRSWDD attorney and come up with a compromise.
3. **Kristian Crowley, Medical Marijuana fees:** John Hamer, the Town attorney, stated that he does not suggest the Selectmen change the Medical Marijuana Ordinance without Town approval. This item will be tabled until next week. John Hamer will be asked if the Selectmen could give Kristian 60 days without revoking his license. Covid-19 has put a strain on the medical marijuana business.
4. **Stillman's Creek:** A bridge will be ordered from Dirigo by the Town. Dean Bradshaw will be contacted concerning the RFP for the project.

MISCELLANEOUS:

5. **Sandy River Beach:** Dennis Moriasey will start work on the cement planks at the end of the landing at Sandy River once he gets some more needed to secure the landing from storm surge.
6. **Sheriff's Dept.; No update.**

7. **Faulkingham Lane needs rosebushes cut back:** Kevin Rocks will be contacted to see if he would be interested in cutting back the rosebushes.
8. RRFB and posts will be delivered tomorrow by the Town of Machias for the Main Street. They will be stored in the Salt/Sand Shed. Dig Safe will be contacted also to make sure no wires are buried underground at the site. MDOT will be providing an engineering plan and provide \$2500. towards the construction.
9. Selectman Milliken confirmed Mike Soucy will be Henry's Points appraiser.

A motion was made by Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectman Fish to adjourn the meeting at 4:40p.m. Selectman Alley and Selectman Fish, both voted "Aye."
