3. **Sawyer Square:** No update
4. **PRSWDD Agreement:** PRSWDD has signed the agreement and the Town's copy should be received soon. A motion was made by Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectman Milliken to have Selectman Fish call the Town attorney, in this case, Kate Grossman.
5. **Sandy River Beach:** Selectman Fish talked with Tim Look about shoring up the concrete planks at the Beach. Tim said he would do what he could within the \$500. Budget.
