NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Open Sand Bids:** The only bid received was from The By "US" Company for \$8.15 per yard. Selectmen Milliken contacted the company and asked if they would consider a four year contract, at that price. The By "US" Company agreed to the cost of \$8.15 for sand during the next four years.

OLD BUSINESS:

2. **Update on bridge delivery:** No Update on delivery-may need to keep Fire Road fully open for the winter.
3. **Review of Adult Marijuana Ordinance by Planning Board:** The Adult Marijuana Ordinance was approved by the Planning Board. Next step will be a public hearing in February 2021.

4. **Response from Superintendent of Schools:** Received communication from Lewis Collins stating he would not be attending the Selectmen's meeting tonight.
5. **FYI: Invoice from Sherriff's Dept.:** Approved for payment.
6. **FYI: Update from visit by Pete Coughlin:** Pete contacted the MDOT crew asking them to repair the catch basins on Main Street with large depressions.
7. **Executive Session: 1 M.S.R.A. 405 (6) E: NO Executive Session was held. Tabled until next week.**

8. Selectman Alley reported that 6 beavers have been caught at Stillman's Creek within the last week.
9. Selectman Fish will check with Inge to see if she will paint the "Town of Jonesport" sign, at the end of Snare Creek Lane.
10. The Selectmen requested that a letter be sent to all taxpayers that are delinquent on their tax agreements. The letter will state that if they do not bring their accounts up to date within 30 days; the conditions of the tax agreement will be enacted.
