NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Road flooding on Mason Bay:** MDOT has been working on pumping out the area that floods Mason Bay Road. Water level down considerably. Hopefully, no flooding during winter.
2. **Letter from CEO:** Table until next week to see if landowner replies to the letter from CEO, referencing putting building too close to shoreline.

OLD BUSINESS:

3. **Request extension from Maine Coastal for grant:** Selectmen anxious to get the amendment signed and returned to Kathleen Leyden with Maine Coastal.
4. **Bridge delivery:** Mark Andrews with Dirigo Timberlands will be contacted to ask when bridge delivery can be expected. The delivery will be coordinated with Jim Carver, who will provide the equipment.

MISCELLANEOUS:

5. **Renewal of Medical Marijuana permit:** A motion was made by Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectman Fish to renew the Medical Marijuana Manufacturing permit. Selectman Alley, Fish and Milliken, all voted “Aye.”
6. **Sandy River Beach, cement lifting:** This project will be tabled until Spring 2021.
