**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. ***Marc Perry, Assessor, formal motion:*** A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Alley, to formally appoint Marc Perry, as the Assessor for the Town of Jonesport.
2. ***Kathleen Leyden, Conference call, 4:10 p.m.:*** The Selectmen had a conference call with Ms. Leyden in reference to the Shore and Harbor grant. She granted the Town a 2 year extension; the situation was explained by Selectman Fish. Information will be forwarded to Kathleen Leyden, when each piece of the project falls into place.
3. ***WCS- Tim Tabbutt, addendum to contract :***The Selectmen signed the addendum as written.
4. ***Acct #433 – foreclosed property still not received funds from bidder due March 10<sup>th</sup>:*** Selectman Alley will contact Selectman Milliken for more information.
5. ***Community Development Block Grant & Northern Border Regional Commission programs:*** Sunrise County Economic Council has taken over the responsibility of these programs. Washington County Council of Government has no staff to perform these functions at present.
