### NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. *Marc Perry, Assessor, formal motion*: A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Alley, to formally appoint Marc Perry, as the Assessor for the Town of Jonesport.
- 2. *Kathleen Leyden, Conference call, 4:10 p.m:* The Selectmen had a conference call with Ms. Leyden in reference to the Shore and Harbor grant. She granted the Town a 2 year extension; the situation was explained by Selectman Fish. Information will be forwarded to Kathleen Leyden, when each piece of the project falls into place.
- 3. WCS- Tim Tabbutt , addendum to contract : The Selectmen signed the addendum as written.
