OLD BUSINESS:

1. **Oil slick on Sawyer Square, Update:** The owner of the property in question was contacted, who in turn called Carver Oil. Carver indicated there didn't appear to be leakage outside. Owner contacted person with a key so the inside could be checked out also. It appears the leak has stopped.
2. **Storm Drain across from 269 Main St., Update:** The MDOT in Jonesboro was contacted. It appears that part of the drainpipe runs under the garage. The supervisor will be contacted to come up with a suitable alternative.
3. **Jeff Balicki property:** Dean Bradshaw looked over the problem and will write a letter listing his suggestions.
4. **Charlene Nelson property, first refusal, Update:** Letter was sent to property owner requesting a document for the Selectmen to sign releasing them of first refusal on the old Cove School.

MISCELLANEOUS:

5. **Kelly Point Rd closure/Fire Road work:** While Dean Bradshaw was in town, he was asked to make suggestions on the Fire Road work. He suggested numerous culverts that would drain into a pit. These pits could potentially stop the road from washing out. David Look, the contractor, was in agreement, along with 4 wider sections of road for vehicles to pull over if needed.
6. **ARPA funds scheduled for Sept, \$130,000:** The funds will be distributed in two payments, one in September and the other in the spring.
7. The Special Town meeting will be held August 25th at the fire station, 6:00 p.m.
