NEW BUSINESS:

1. **WWAPP funding:** Elaine Abbot of Sunrise County Economic Development Council, is checking with the State to ascertain if the LMF covenant precludes the town for applying for more assistance.
2. **Septic replacement funds:** A motion was made by Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectman Fish, to have Kathy Killian, as an assistant to the Selectmen, work extra hours to determine if the town qualifies and what the application process is for these funds.

OLD BUSINESS:

3. **Letter to Stubbs family:** A motion was made by Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectman Fish to write a letter of reprieve to Ms. Stubbs until April 15th, 2022, for removal of her storage shed. Copies were sent Ed Stubbs and Nancy Durkee.

MISCELLANEOUS:

4. **Broadband/Internet Access:** The Selectmen approved Axiom attending the February 9th meeting, to explain how the town can better accommodate the people in town who are unable to connect to a strong broadband signal.
5. **Share of school expense for John:** John Church will attend Harbor Master School, March 2nd through March 4th, the Town of Beals has asked the Selectmen to approve half of the expense. A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken to approve the expense. The cost to Jonesport will be \$137.50.

6. Printing of Annual Town Report: Brett Pawlowski of Jonesport will print the town report for 2022.

7. Versant -meter replacement: In the next few months, Versant Power will be replacing the electric meters in Town. There will be a link placed on the town website to allow people who have no interested in this to opt out.
