NEW BUSINESS:

1. **David Burns-mowing Jonesport end of bridge by Coast Guard Station:** David would like \$21 each time he mows the triangular area near the bridge.

OLD BUSINESS:

2. **Broadband/Internet Access presentation:** The Selectmen would like to meet with a representative of Spectrum to see if they will give the town what we need for broadband.
3. **LMF-Mike Soucy:** Laura, with LMF, was contacted and she is directing Mike to get the survey of the Campground, ASAP.
4. **Washington Cty. Sheriff Memorandum of Understanding:** After a motion was made by Selectman Fish and seconded by Selectman Alley, the Memorandum of Understanding was signed and given to Tim Tabbutt.
5. **Articles:** The articles were perused, then corrections were made.

6. **Report on grant writing, planning & the Island Fellows:** Selectmen Fish explained the application for the Island Fellows and that he thought the article in the Town Report should not exclude advertising locally for a grant writer/planner.
