OLD BUSINESS:

2. **Short version of Campground assessment:** The Selectmen were pleased with the assessment placed on the Campground. Marc Perry will have the full report available soon.

3. **Certificates of appointment expired at Town Meeting 2022:** The only Certificate of appointment signed was for Paul Newcomb. The others are waiting for Selectman Alley to return.
4. **Letter from Franklin Smith (Planning Board Chairman) to be read aloud:** The purpose of the letter was in support of the reappointment of Tonia Merchant, as the Planning Board secretary. It was read aloud by Selectman Milliken.
