NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Committee for the Solar Power Ordinance:** The Planning Board submitted a letter to the Selectmen, asking them to appoint more members to the committee. An ad will appear in the newspaper for two weeks. The prospective members will need to submit a letter of intent and the interview process will start on June 8th.

OLD BUSINESS:

2. **Advice from Attorney, Moratorium Regarding the Development and Operation of Commercial Aquaculture Facilities Petition & Amendment to the Recall of Elected Municipal Officers Ordinance:** Information about the two petitions was received from Attorney Hamer. The only visible problem he reported was the General Affidavit had no address for the person submitting the petitions. The statement of facts was corrected, and the Selectmen asked it to be resubmitted to Attorney Hamer.
3. **Approve articles for School Town Meeting:** The Selectmen changed the articles and then they were approved for the June 2nd school budget meeting.
4. **Appoint Local Emergency Officer, executive session 1M.R.S.A. § 405(6)(A):** The Selectmen went into executive session at 4:20 p.m. and returned to the general meeting at 4:30 p.m. Selectman Fish made a motion to elect Daniel Thibodeau, as the Local Emergency Management Director, seconded by Selectman Alley, with the condition that his training is completed within 90 days after his appointment.

MISCELLANEOUS:

5. **FYI Ms. Killian collaborating with owner on Feeney Street to help with funding opportunities:** The Selectmen discussed the problem but without Jim Carver in attendance couldn't offer any suggestions.

6. **Mowing in town:** The North Street Cemetery needs to be kept mowed this year. Mason Bay Mowing has expressed no interest in mowing cemeteries. It was suggested to ask Andrew Bertrand to take on the task.
7. **Mr. Collins will be asked to attend the June 1st meeting.** There will be a presentation by AFLAC staff members.
8. The Selectmen asked that Maine Municipal be contacted to answer two questions. The first pertains to whether any public officer can view potential hazards i.e., decomposed trash or rodents. The second question pertains to a mailbox placed on the corner of Leland Faulkingham's property hindering him from using his gate.
