1. **Zoom meeting with Laura Graham, Land for Maine’s Future,**
Refusal of appraisal: The Selectmen need to find another appraiser. Ms. Graham feels that would be better than hiring the same professional again. An article will be in the Special Town Meeting warrant.

OLD BUSINESS:

2. **Appoint additional members for Solar Moratorium Committee, Executive Session1**
M.R.S.A. § 405 (6) A: Selectman Fish made a motion to go into executive session, seconded by Selectman Alley at 5:05 p.m. Kris Kelesian cited that an executive session is not needed: Selectmen returned to open session at 5:10 p.m. Carrie Peabody and Kris Kelesian were interviewed. The Planning Board had recommended four members of their board to serve on the committee. Selectman Fish asked questions and read the letters from Ms. Peabody and Mr. Kelesian. The four recommended by the Planning Board will be appointed.
3. **Reaffirm RFPs for Henry’s Point:** Selectman Fish made a motion to reaffirm the RFP for Henry’s Point, seconded by Selectman Alley.


MISCELLANEOUS:
