1. **Extension of Solar Moratorium:** Selectman Milliken made a motion to extend the Solar Moratorium for an additional 6 month, seconded by Selectman Fish.

2. **Approve articles for Special Town Meeting:** Selectman Fish made a motion to set the date of the Special Town meeting to June 20th at 6:00 p.m.
Find venue: A venue will be selected by the July 6th meeting.

Note from MMA: A note was requested by MMA regarding appropriations. The MMA reported that funds may be appropriated at an annual town meeting or at special town meetings throughout the year.

3. **ARPA funds:** The second tranche of funds has been received and the scope of use of the funds has been expanded. Selectmen will make decision on how to spend the funds after talking to a representative from Spectrum.

4. **Meeting Washington County of Governments:** An RSVP will be sent to the Washington County of Governments for all three of the selectmen.
5. **Additional Appraisers for LMF:** The email containing the additional appraisers will be sent to Selectmen Milliken. He will contact them. Also, Elaine Abbott will be contacted to ensure that she is aware of the criteria needed for Henry's Point.
6. **Complaint at Sandy River Beach:** There was a complaint of dogs running free on Sandy River Beach. The Selectmen will check out the dog ordinance next week.
7. **Office Closure, Thursday, June 30th at 1:00 p.m. for year-end:** Selectman Fish made a motion to close the office Thursday, June 30th at 1:00 p.m. for year end processing, seconded by Selectman Alley.
8. Ellery Alley has been working on the old high school site that the Town has earmarked for a new Veteran's Monument. Selectman Fish made a motion to allow up to \$1000 for preliminary work to get ready for the monument to be placed. Selectman Alley seconded the motion.
9. Tonia requested funds from contingency. There is an overdraft of \$158.63 in the Salt/sand shed account and \$1,295.41 in the Street Light account. Selectman Fish made a motion to take the total of \$1,454.04 out of the contingency account; Selectman Alley seconded it.
