3. **Approve articles for Special Town Meeting:** Selectman Fish made a motion, seconded by Selectman Milliken to approve the articles for the July 20th Special Town meeting.

5. **Complaint at Sandy River Beach:** The Selectmen reviewed the Jonesport Animal Control Ordinance and decided to order two signs that followed the wording in the Ordinance, which gives more control over the dogs on the Beach.

Kris Kelesian asked that the Selectmen request a teleconference with Versant because he and other members of the audience have not been able to get consistent answers concerning the new electric meters Versant has scheduled to install. The teleconference will be scheduled on a Wednesday at 4 pm.

An executive session was called concerning personnel, 1 M.R.S.A. 405 (6) A. The Selectmen went into executive session at 5:05 p.m. and returned to the general assembly at 5:10p.m. A motion was made by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Milliken to close the Town Clerk's office on Thursday, July 7th , as both the Clerk and Deputy cannot be available. The Selectmen's office will remain open.
