NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Formal Request for take no action letter:** Selectman Fish made a motion to take no action in response to a letter sent by Robert McNeally in reference to land of the Enid Kelley property and to send draft a proclamation to that effect, seconded by Selectman Alley. Selectman Milliken recused himself and took a seat in the audience.

OLD BUSINESS:

2. **Jim Carver, report on roads:** Selectman Fish made a motion to have the office contact Dean Bradshaw to work with Jim Carver on developing specs for the road project, seconded by Selectman Alley. Approved.

MISCELLANEOUS:

3. **Alcohol referendum:** Mr. Hamer is developing an alcohol referendum plan for the November election.
4. **Paper Talks:** Selectman Fish made a motion to accept the price of \$254 to continue the Town ad in Paper Talks, seconded by Selectman Alley. Approved.

5. **Problem with campers using Fire Road:** There are issues with campers turning into the Campground Road when approaching from the Fire Road. There is not enough room to swing in. The bridge will not be started for another month so shouldn't affect the campers that much.
6. **FYI permitting process for marine aquaculture leases/licenses:** No comments.
7. MDOT has sent a bridge program manager to look over the two bridges on Main Street and today a surveyor came in looking for a map that included Donovan's Creek. It looks like the State is moving forward with plans to restructure the two bridges.
8. There was discussion about the trash at the Marina. Selectman Milliken made a motion to have the office contact Hector at Casella to see if the dumpster can be lettered, seconded by Selectman Alley. Approved.
9. Dwight Smith Jr. will be contacted by the office to expand the sliding hill towards the access road.
10. Ambulance payment will be stretched out to payments that are more acceptable by the Director. Renee Gray will be contacted by the office to see what payments would be better for the ambulance department.
