- 2. **State Valuation for 2023:** The Selectmen discussed the valuation for Jonesport \$188, 300 compared to Eastport \$165,750 and Machias \$172,950. Valuation for Jonesport in 2022 was \$174,700, Eastport was \$154,900 and Machias \$155,100. Selectman Fish will give an update after the Washington County budget meeting next week.
