1. **Proposal of due diligence from Haley Ward for Henry's Point, a motion to allow Selectman Fish to sign if WWAC accepts proposal as written:** Selectman Milliken made a motion to have Selectman Fish sign the Due Diligence proposal from Haley Ward, Selectman Alley seconded the motion, if WWAC accepts the proposal as written.

MISCELLANEOUS and FYI:

2. **State Valuation for 2022 and 2023:** Selectman Milliken asked for ten years of State Valuations.
3. **Bridge flooding fill out forms Donovan Creek and Cross Cove:** The Selectmen worked on the bridge flooding information that will be submitted to MDOT.
4. **Broadband Update:** Information gathered by the Selectmen's office was shared with the Selectmen. There is an application for free lunch issued by the federal government. Even though all students attending Jonesport schools receive free lunch, if the applications were filled out by parents, the families may qualify for free or reduced Internet costs. Selectmen Milliken suggested contacting Lew Collins with this information.
5. **Junkyard: The junkyard is worse than it was years ago.** Betsy Fitzgerald, CEO, will be contacted to go to the Fire Road and see the condition of the property. Pictures will be sent to her. All junkyard cases must be approached the same way.

6. **Headstone:** The headstone discovered near Donovan Cove Bridge is not associated with any burial ground. The Rumerys are buried at the Greenwood Cemetery. The headstone will be left there for the owners of the property to determine what they want to do with it.
7. **Executive Session 1 M.R.S.A. § 405(6) (A):** The Selectmen met with two members of the office staff to discuss a self-assessment form. Selectman Fish made a motion to enter executive session at 4:50 p.m., Selectman Alley seconded the motion. The general meeting resumed at 5:30 p.m.

Jim Carver suggested at the last meeting, there be a prequalification meeting for the road contractors who will be filling out the RFP forms for the 4 roads in disrepair in Jonesport. The project has been put off until spring. Jim will be asked to grade the four roads before winter, along with the Fire Road.

There will be a verification done to see who is still on the Economic Council Committee, then a meeting will be held in the beginning of the new year.
