- 2. **Alcohol referendum:** Selectman Fish made a motion to validate the minutes from November 8, 2022, seconded by Selectman Milliken.


**MISCELLANEOUS and FYI:**

- 3. **State Valuation reports from 2002 to 2023:** Selectman Milliken will be looking the reports over to see if there are any discrepancies that keep the Jonesport State valuation increasing each year.
- 4. **Broadband Update:** Mr. Collins. Superintendent of Schools will be contacted to see if he will get an actual number of students that qualify for free/reduced lunch.
