OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Commercial Solar Ordinance Committee:** Letter from William Nunan regarding moratorium extension was read aloud by Selectman Milliken. Motion by Selectman Fish, seconded by Selectman Alley to support option #2. Motion carried. The office will thank the committee for their work and encourage the committee to proceed.
- 2. Littering Complaint:** The selectmen asked the office to contact the individual that placed the complaint and advise that Route 187 is a state road and there is a state law against littering with a \$500 fine possible if caught. Any citizen can organize a clean-up and in the past, the town has purchased the trash bags and helped with the cost of disposal. The selectmen asked the office to contact the county jail to see if clean-up/work crews are available.

MISCELLANEOUS and FYI:

- 3. Kelley Point Road Bridge Update:** The second level of concrete was poured November 30, 2022. Setting the blocks for the bridge will begin on December 1, 2022.
- 4. Private vs. Public Road Maintenance Discussion:** Property owner Dan Lozaro presented questions about town participation in the maintenance of private roads within the town of

Jonesport. The selectmen explained that only public roads are maintained by the town and explained the process that other landowners have followed to have their private road taken over by the town.
