NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Board of Appeals Ordinance:** A secretary must be appointed each year by the Selectboard. Tonia Merchant was asked if she wanted the position, but she refused. The Chairman of the board will be notified and ask if the board may request a nominee for secretary at the next meeting.

OLD BUSINESS:

2. **Approve Minutes of General Assistance Ordinance Public Hearing:** Selectman Milliken made a motion to approve the minutes of the public hearing, seconded by Selectman Alley.
3. **Junkyard Update:** Selectman Fish reported by driving down the Fire Road there are still big items in the yard. He does feel this junkyard has had small items removed by the owner.

4. **Kelley Point Road Bridge Update:** The bridge is mostly finished and on Dec. 6th opened to the public. There is minor work to be done i.e., guardrails and gravel brought in. The road will be closed again when the guardrails are ready for installation.

There is a well that residents on Feeney Street still use. Eric Kelley will be asked to check on the survey and other available information.
