- 1. **Broadband Committee interviews: Executive session 1 M.R.S.A.§ 405(6)(A):** Interviews with Clifford Norton III and Diane Smith were held, and both were appointed to the Broadband Committee. Selectman Alley made a motion to sign Certificates of Appointment for both Diane and Clifford, Selectman Fish seconded the motion.

- 3. **Contract small animal clinic 2023:** Jadah Alley has shown an interest in housing stray cats. She needs to come up with a list of fees and costs. Also, ask her about State licensing.
- 4. **Articles for town meeting:** A lot of the articles can be tabled until the school budget meeting in May. The Selectmen had questions concerning the articles that were for raising matching funds for grants.
- 5. **MMA dues:** The Maine Municipal Association dues were approved for the 2023 year. There were \$2,712. Selectman Alley, seconded by Selectman Fish to approve the expenditure.
