NEW BUSINESS:


- 1. Executive session 1 M.R.S.A. §405(6)(A) to interview various committee members and potential appointees:** Selectman Fish made a motion to enter Executive Session at 4:01 PM; seconded by Selectman Alley. Motion Carried. Regular Meeting was called to order at 4:40 PM.
- 2. David Burns/Trim It Up Lawn Care Bids:** Mr. Burns presented a bid proposal for five (5) properties that he would like to mow and trim on a scheduled or as-needed basis. One of the properties is a cemetery that the family maintains, and two (2) have been contracted to others over the past few years and Selectmen will await their bids before awarding the jobs. Mr. Burns agreed to trim around the Welcome to Jonesport signs a couple of times a year (\$20.00 per sign each time); Jonesport Marina grass and weeds around the building, dumpster and porta-potty (\$30.00 each time); and the approaches on the Jonesport-Beals Bridge (same price as last year).

OLD BUSINESS:

- 3. List of Possible Interviews for Certificate of Appointment:** Four (4) interviews are needed and will be scheduled by office staff for March 1, 2023 if the position terms expire at Town Meeting or March 15, 2023 if expiration is after Town Meeting.

MISCELLANEOUS and FYI:

- 4. FYI - Kelley Point Road Bridge:** Jim Carver has been contacted about the potholes in the new bridge surface and repair should be done sometime next week. Paving scheduled for later in the spring.



5. **FYI – Jim Carver Specs for Feeney Street, Alexander Ave., E. Norton Circle, and Lamson Lane:** Jim Carver was contacted regarding the progress of specifications for repairs and paving to be done in 2023. He hopes to complete by next week and will meet with Harry to discuss details to assist in preparation of Proposal Requests.
6. **FYI - Articles for town meeting:** Selectmen’s Assistant Irene Rogers is finalizing the Articles for the Selectmen’s signatures. They need to be completed by next week to go to the printer on time and to be ready for posting in advance of Town Meeting.
7. **MISC – CEO Report on Junkyard progress:** Selectman Alley questioned whether we have a recent progress report. Office Staff will follow up with the CEO.
8. **MISC – Old Sand Pile location:** A mobile home appears to have been abandoned at the location of the old sand pile on Mason Bay Road. Axle appears to be broken. The responsible party will be contacted and put on notice that the mobile home and debris need to be removed.
