# Feb 27 – actions

- 4. Get input from neighboring towns, Beals, Jonesboro, Addison, etc for regional effort.

- 3. Jim to talk to Fidium to get details on consumer model.
- 4. Julie to talk to Spectrum and keep researching other ISP's identified from earlier 2021 town survey.

# Pertinant info:

- Open access promotes competition (all ISP's will be invited to use the fiber) which is best for the consumer. However, Axiom, Fidium and Spectrum will not use any fiber that they don't own, so essentially it's still a closed network.
- It's often easier to 'sell' the project to local Government and residents if they are assured that they will own the network that they have just paid for.
