

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Review applications for Assessor position:** There was one application submitted for Assessor; Barbara Cirone. Selectperson Fish made a motion to appoint her as assessor with a start date of mid-July. Selectperson Alley seconded the motion. A contract will be drawn up for Barbie.
2. **Planning Board:**
 - a. **Change to Maine dwelling regulations:** The Planning Board will come up with a proposal at their next meeting.
 - b. **Moratorium on windmills:** A moratorium will be prepared in reference to the windmills for the next Planning Board meeting.
 - c. **Use of Zoom Account:** Diane Smith, as secretary of the Planning Board, will be added to the Town's Zoom account.
 - d. **FYI: ad for alternate members:** Selectperson Cilley will include an ad for alternate members of the Planning Board and Board of Appeals on a public website she manages.
