Then a special town meeting would be called to see if the voters would approve the town maintenance of the road. Mr. Dennis felt that that the landowners would have no problem with deeding the right of way to the town.
- 2. **Paula McCormick,** Beals Selectperson, asked the Town of Jonesport to transfer their ownership in a lot of land on Alley's Bay and the chapel building to the Town of Beals so the chapel can obtain insurance. The building was a decommissioned schoolhouse on Head Harbor Island and was moved to Alley's Bay when Beals was still a part on Jonesport.
