To: Howard Mills, resident of the Town of Jonesport, in the County of Washington, State of Maine.

Greetings: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Jonesport, qualified to vote in Town Affairs, to assemble at the Jonesport Elementary Gymnasium at Snare Creek, in said Town on Wednesday, the twenty-fifth (25th) day of August 2021, at 6:00 p.m., to act on the following articles, to wit:

Motion was made and seconded to dispense the reading of the warrant in its entirety. Motion carried; none opposed.

ARTICLE 1: To elect, by ballot, a Moderator to reside at said meeting;

Nomination was made and seconded for William (Billy) Milliken.

Motion was made and seconded for nominations to cease; none opposed.

1 ballot was cast in favor of Billy Milliken.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to accept the Jonesport Ordinance for the Adult Use of Marijuana as written; the Ordinance allows the operation of adult use marijuana store, cultivation facilities, products manufacturing facilities and testing facilities, provided they operate in compliance with all applicable state and local requirements.

Motion was made and seconded to accept the proposed ordinance.


It was explained that this article would only approve the actual ordinance. The ordinance would regulate however, there would still need to be a referendum Town vote to opt in.
