Tonia J. Merchant opened the meeting. Irene Rogers served as Ballot Clerk. David Wardwell, Barbara Malcarne, and Lynn Alley served as Ballot Tellers.

To: Howard Mills, resident of the Town of Jonesport, in the County of Washington, State of Maine.

Greetings: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Jonesport, qualified to vote in Town Affairs, to assemble at the Jonesport Elementary School at Snare Creek, in said Town on Wednesday, the eleventh (11th) day of April 2018, at 6:00 p.m., to act on the following articles, to wit:

ARTICLE 1: To elect, by ballot, a Moderator to preside at said meeting:

Nominations were made for Tonia Merchant, Julie Farris, and Irene Rogers all of which declined before being seconded. Nomination was made and seconded for William (Billy) Milliken.

Motion was made and seconded for nominations to cease.

4 votes were cast in favor of William Milliken.

Billy Milliken led in the salute to our Country's flag.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to allow the Jonesport Elementary School to borrow from the Town's surplus \$79,800 for the repair of the building roof; the amount including interest, to be repaid over two years at \$40,800.00 each year beginning July 2018.

Motion was made and seconded to accept the article as written. Motion carried; none opposed.

Motion was made and seconded to adjourn; none opposed. Meeting adjourned at 6:24 p.m.
