WARRANT FOR SECRET BALLOT ELECTION
Local Option Liquor Referendum Questions 1 and 3

To: Howard Mills, a Special Constable of the Town of Jonesport, in the County of Washington, State of Maine,

Greetings: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Jonesport in said county and state, qualified by law to vote in Town Affairs, to meet at the Jonesport Town Office located at 70 Snare Creek Lane, in said Town on Tuesday, the eighth (8th) day of November, A.D. 2022, at 8 o'clock in the morning., then and there to act upon Article 1 and by secret ballot on Article 2 and Article 3 as set out below, the polling hours therefore, to be from eight o'clock in the morning until eight o'clock in the evening, said articles being the following:

Article 1: To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting to vote by written ballot.

Article 2: "Shall this municipality authorize the State to issue licenses for the sale of liquor to be consumed on the premises of licensed establishments on days other than Sundays?"

Article 3: "Shall this municipality authorize the State to issue licenses for the sale of liquor to be consumed on the premises of licensed establishments on all days including Sundays?"
